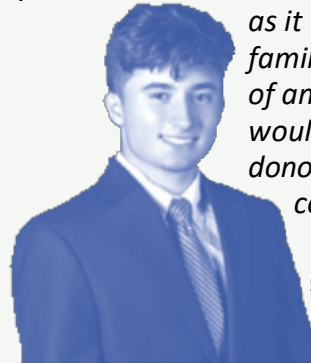

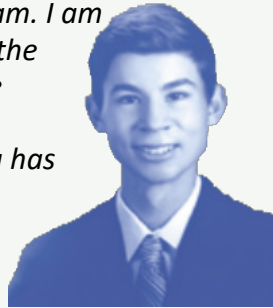

REBRAND

The Westchester Golf Association Caddie Scholarship Fund (WGACSF) as of March 15, 2023 completed a major rebranding and is now conducting business as the Metropolitan Golf Association Caddie Scholarship Fund (MGACSF). By aligning with the Metropolitan Golf Association, the Fund’s efforts to provide need-based scholarships to college-bound students will be strengthened and continue to grow, while enhanced messaging about the Fund will increase awareness to all stakeholders.

OUR MISSION

The MGA Caddie Scholarship Fund (CSF) fosters the core values of personal responsibility, integrity and perseverance by giving young men and women in service to golf the opportunity to further enhance their lives through the pursuit of higher education. The Fund provides college scholarships to qualified candidates based on financial need.

OUR HISTORY

The CSF was established in 1956 by renowned amateur golfer Willie P. Turnesa and his good friend Udo Reinach. With 2,946 recipients since its founding, the Caddie Scholarship Fund has provided in excess of \$26,000,000 in scholarship funding.

OUR SCHOLARSHIPS

The CSF is one of the largest organizations of its kind in the nation. The Caddie scholarship awards range from \$1,000 to \$12,500 per year for undergraduate study or for study at an accredited trade school. Maximum awards are awarded to exceptional students with exceptional need.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants must demonstrate financial need, have applied to or currently attend an accredited school, and have worked a minimum of two seasons in service to golf at a local club in Bronx, Dutchess, Orange, Putnam, Rockland, Sullivan, Ulster, Westchester and Fairfield (CT) counties. Service to golf includes caddieing, golf course maintenance, and work in the golf shop, bag room or on the practice range. Club members and their children are not eligible to apply.

MGA CADDIE SCHOLARSHIP FUND

FUNDING

The CSF finances scholarship awards primarily through contributions from individuals, local golf and country clubs, alumni, corporations, and foundations.

NAMED AND ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIPS

Named and endowed scholarships give donors an opportunity to celebrate their commitment to education and golf. These special scholarships provide an enduring legacy for individuals, families and organizations to pay tribute to an individual or organization.

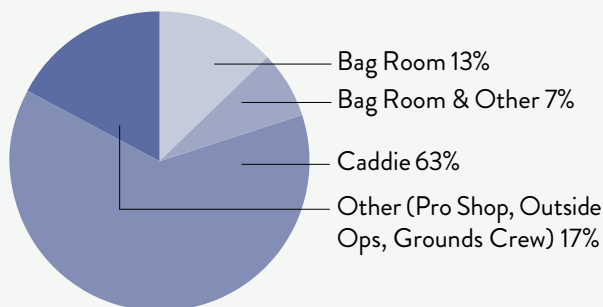

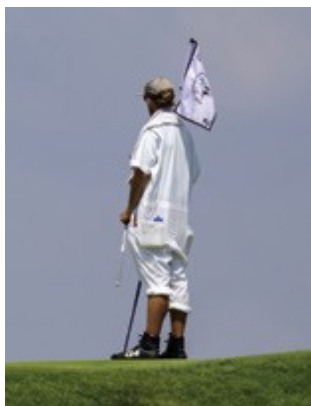

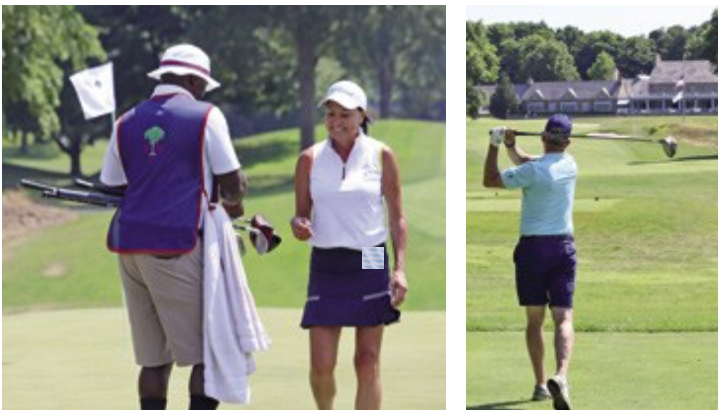

CSF PRO-AM

The CSF held its 41st Annual Pro-Am at the Round Hill Club on July 11th. A double shotgun start was held, with the field divided by 8:30 am and 1:30 pm.

In the morning competition, the team of Mario Guerra, Quaker Ridge Golf Club, captured first in the low-net competition, while the team of Kevin Ausserlechner, Mount Kisco Country Club, won the gross competition. In the afternoon wave the group of Sean Hand from Fairview Country Club, finished first in the low net and Morgan Gregory's team finished first in the low gross.

Lexus sponsored a hole in one competition on the par 3, 17th, while Titleist, B. Draddy and Fairway and Green provided gifts for the competitors. The Pro-Am has been an annual tradition for more than 40 years and is one of the fundraising staples of the CSF. Proceeds from the event directly benefit the CSF's caddie scholarship recipients.

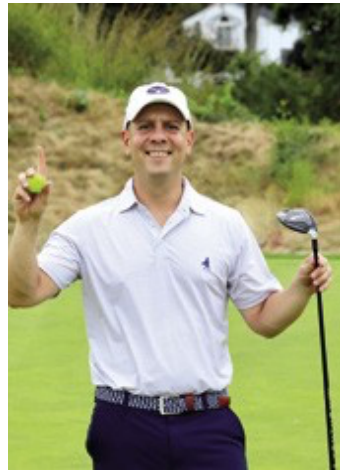

For a second time in as many years, the Marathon broke fundraising records. In 2022, the event total and individual fundraising total were smashed, while the marathoners combined to golf the most holes in event history.

EVENTS

CSF GOLF MARATHON

On Monday, August 22, the Caddie Scholarship Fund held its annual Golf Marathon at Shorehaven Golf Club in Norwalk, CT.

The field featured 48 golfers, making it one of the largest fields in event history. For a second year in a row, the fundraising record was shattered. Over \$250,000 was raised and a combined 2,796 holes (also a record) were played in less than 12 hours.

Joe Pica of Shorehaven raised over \$123,000 this year, setting a record for most money raised by an individual. He broke his 2021 record of \$93,000. Rob Lupica, CSF alumnus, played the most holes at this year's marathon: 122. He was one of four golfers to play over 100 holes. The marathon also featured a hole in one on the fifth hole from Leo Cohen of Shorehaven.

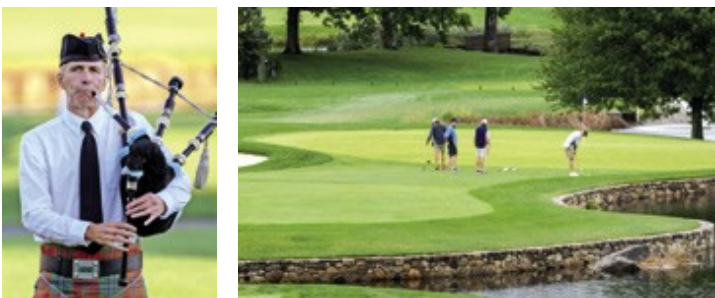

After a cloudy start at Darien, the sun broke through for a beautiful ending to a special day. Bagpipes and a banquet capped a celebration of Chris Hickey as the event surpassed \$1 million raised since its inception.

EVENTS

7TH ANNUAL CHRISTOPHER C. HICKEY GOLF INVITATIONAL

The Christopher C. Hickey Invitational was held at the Country Club of Darien on September 22. Started in 2016 by CSF board member Greg Hickey, the CCH Invitational serves as a very special event paying tribute to his late twin brother Chris.

This year’s event highlighted a few firsts for the CCH Invitational. The winning team featured the first female winner in the tournament’s history. It also featured a participant who stepped off a red eye just moments before the shotgun start. The event’s gross proceeds topped \$100,000 for yet another year, bringing the seven-year total of the event to \$1,000,000 in gross proceeds. The CCH Invitational continues to be one of the largest single-day fundraisers for the Fund and has now helped award twenty-one CCH Scholarship recipients.
