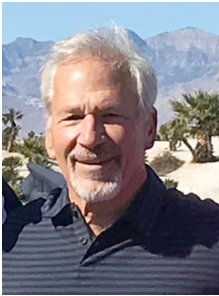

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE



EACH YEAR, the President of the Caddie Scholarship Fund addresses our friends, donors, scholars and all associated with this worthy and rewarding effort to review the successes of the past year and to preview what the coming season will bring.

At this moment in time however, the coronavirus has pushed our country into a crisis, the likes of which none of us have ever seen, and for the foreseeable future, business will not proceed as usual.

Despite these dire circumstances, we know that we will regroup, our economy will restart and our children will return to school to pursue their dreams. And we know that, with your help, we will be there to assist those in need.

By normal standards, the past year was a successful one for us, as we awarded over \$1.1 million to 273 students in the 2019/20 academic year. We were blessed with several unsolicited endowed donations from Bob Thomas, the American Seniors Golf Association on behalf of Joe Germano, and an overwhelming outpouring of support in memory of caddie scholar alumnus Tommy Goff.

Our annual fundraising events, including the bag tag program, our Pro-Am, our Marathon, the Christopher C. Hickey Invitational and our alumni tournament were all

quite successful, allowing us to award a larger amount to each of our caddie scholars. We are quite excited about our lineup of clubs this year, particularly our Pro-Am to be held at Sleepy Hollow in July.

Our fund's success was somewhat bittersweet, as we lost two past presidents, Mr. Robert J. Bluestone and Mr. John J. Pinto; and two long-time board members, Mrs. Gloria Bogle and Mr. Oliver Lazare. Our sincere condolences to their families.

We are very proud to announce that last month, one of our local caddies from Winged Foot Golf Club was awarded a prestigious Westchester-Evans full tuition and board scholarship to his chosen university. These scholarships are co-sponsored by the Evans Scholars Foundation and our WGA Caddie Scholarship Fund. Over the few years that Evans has been awarding scholarships in our area, we have found a community of interests with them, and continue to look for ways to create a synergy that benefits our local kids.

We hope to see all of you at our events during the season, but at the risk of repeating advice you have heard over and over again, please do the smart thing, follow the appropriate health guidelines and above all keep your safety and those of your loved ones uppermost in your mind.

We will get through this, and we may be battered, but we will be unbroken.

OUR MISSION

The WGA Caddie Scholarship Fund (CSF) fosters the core values of personal responsibility, integrity and perseverance by giving young men and women in service to golf the opportunity to further enhance their lives through the pursuit of higher education. The Fund provides college scholarships to qualified candidates based on financial need.

OUR HISTORY

The WGA Caddie Scholarship Fund was established in 1956 by renowned amateur golfer Willie P. Turnesa and his good friend Udo Reinach. With 2,811 recipients since its founding, the Caddie Scholarship Fund has provided in excess of \$22,000,000 in scholarship funding.

OUR SCHOLARSHIPS

The CSF is one of the largest organizations of its kind in the nation. Caddie scholarship awards range from \$1,000 to \$10,000 per year for undergraduate study or for study at an accredited trade school. Maximum awards are awarded to exceptional students with exceptional need.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants must demonstrate financial need, have applied to or currently attend an accredited school, and have worked a minimum of two seasons in service to golf at a local club in Westchester and other surrounding counties in NY and CT. Service to golf includes caddieing, golf course maintenance, and work in the golf shop, bag room or on the practice range. Club members and their children are not eligible to apply.

FUNDING

The CSF finances scholarship awards primarily through contributions from individuals, local golf and country clubs, alumni, corporations, and foundations.

NAMED AND ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIPS

Named and endowed scholarships give donors an opportunity to celebrate their commitment to education and golf. These special scholarships provide an enduring legacy for individuals, families and organizations to pay tribute to an individual or organization.

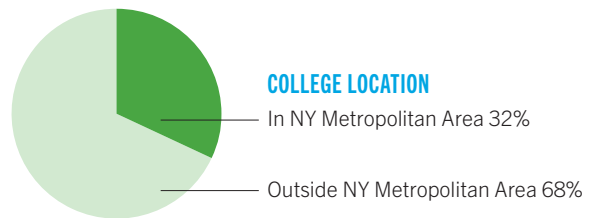
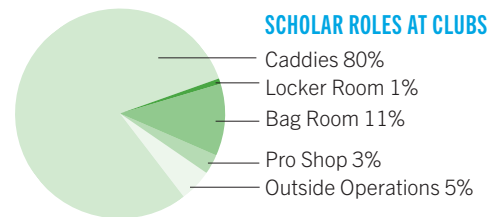
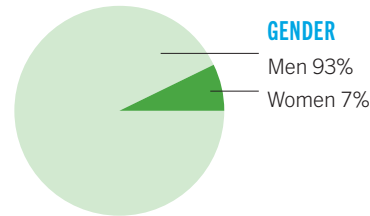

ABOUT THE THOMAS M. GOFF MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Thomas "Tommy" M. Goff, CSF Class of 2007, passed away suddenly on March 30, 2019. A friend to many on and off of the golf course, this scholarship fund has been established by Tommy's friends and family to honor his legacy.



Tommy began caddieing at Knollwood Country Club in 1999 at the age of 14. He continued to loop at Knollwood (even until recently) through his time at The Hackley School in

Tarrytown, where he played on the varsity golf team and while he was an undergrad at Fordham University. Upon graduation, he joined Hudson Valley Bank and shortly thereafter became a member of Knollwood Country Club. However, it was his life-long dream to become a Yonkers police officer. In 2015, Tommy fulfilled his dream and was a police officer for the City of Yonkers for the past three and a half years until he passed away.

Tommy was a member of the Police Emerald Society, the Friendly Sons of St. Patrick, the International Association of Approved Basketball Officials, and a parishioner of the Monastery Church of the Sacred Heart. He was an active WGACSF Alumnus, having participated in many Alumni Reunion Outings contributing annually.

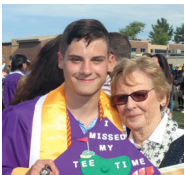
