PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE



THERE ARE certain events in the spring that renew our positive outlook. Pitchers and catchers reporting to spring training is one example, and the beginning of a new golf season is another. One year ago, no one could have imagined the course of the pandemic that befell the world in 2020. We are not out of the woods yet but the arrival of the 2021 season certainly lifts our spirits.

We did lower our expectations for 2020 in light of the pandemic, but ultimately our member clubs stepped up to the plate, and our donations were only slightly impaired. In fact, our main fundraising events were quite successful, and many thanks to our staff and all the club managers and caddie managers who creatively adjusted to restrictions and made that possible.

Our new association with Gabelli Management Company (GAMCO) has been quite successful, with our annual return exceeding 33%. In addition, Mr. Gabelli's foundation has also made a generous donation to our fund.

During the winter, we finalized our Strategic Alliance with the Evans Scholarship Fund, and we will reap many social and financial benefits from this association. It has been a pleasure working with Evans, and meeting a group of people who are as dedicated as we are to the success of

local youth caddie programs. It is important to note that all benefits of this association will inure to kids from the same area we have been serving in our 65 years of existence. In fact four local students have received Westchester-Evans full ride scholarships to college this year.

In addition to increasing club and individual donations, we are seeking to increase the number of caddies that we support. Our focus is on helping youth caddies and others in service to golf obtain a quality college education, when their own resources fall short. The payoff is a group of citizens who have absorbed the values that golf imparts and who are armed with the education that enables their success. This cycle is what keeps our clubs and our way of life viable. The more candidates we find, the better for us all.

We hope is that area clubs will re-invigorate their youth caddie programs, and colleges will once again welcome students for a full time in-person education. We ask that all of you urge the governing bodies of your clubs to focus on attracting, training and employing youth caddies during the season and of course, conforming to whatever Covid restrictions are in place.

I would personally like to welcome Polly Sparling, the daughter of our co-founder, Willie Turnesa to our group of directors, and who will co-chair our scholarship committee.

I wish all of you good health, safe choices, and two shots that will return us to normalcy before long.

OUR MISSION

The WGA Caddie Scholarship Fund (CSF) fosters the core values of personal responsibility, integrity and perseverance by giving young men and women in service to golf the opportunity to further enhance their lives through the pursuit of higher education. The Fund provides college scholarships to qualified candidates based on financial need.

OUR HISTORY

The WGA Caddie Scholarship Fund was established in 1956 by renowned amateur golfer Willie P. Turnesa and his good friend Udo Reinach. With 2,863 recipients since its founding, the Caddie Scholarship Fund has provided in excess of \$23,000,000 in scholarship funding.

OUR SCHOLARSHIPS

The CSF is one of the largest organizations of its kind in the nation. Caddie scholarship awards range from \$1,000 to \$10,000 per year for undergraduate study or for study at an accredited trade school. Maximum awards are awarded to exceptional students with exceptional need.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants must demonstrate financial need, have applied to or currently attend an accredited school, and have worked a minimum of two seasons in service to golf at a local club in Westchester and other surrounding counties in NY and CT. Service to golf includes caddieing, golf course maintenance, and work in the golf shop, bag room or on the practice range. Club members and their children are not eligible to apply.

FUNDING

The CSF finances scholarship awards primarily through contributions from individuals, local golf and country clubs, alumni, corporations, and foundations.

NAMED AND ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIPS

Named and endowed scholarships give donors an opportunity to celebrate their commitment to education and golf. These special scholarships provide an enduring legacy for individuals, families and organizations to pay tribute to an individual or organization.

TRIBUTE TO TWO SPECIAL FRIENDS



MARY ODOM

Mary Odom, the daughter of Udo Reinach, the co-founder of the WGA Caddie Scholarship Fund, passed away in November 2020 at the beautiful age of 95! Mary was blessed with four children, Bill, Van,

Drew and Susan. Today, Bill is actively involved with the Fund and serves on the Board of Directors.

Mary had a life that was truly well lived. In the 1950s, while raising four children, she became an accomplished basset hound breeder. Mary was well known in the American Kennel Association and sold several of her pure-bred puppies to Marilyn Monroe and Jack Parr to name a few. In addition, when Elvis Presley was on the Steve Allen show in 1956 and sang hound dog, it was Mary's dog that sat with a top hat on a table very calmly listening to Elvis!

In 1959, Mary met Maje Odom, a thoroughbred horse trainer. Mary sold her "Best in Show" basset hound and bought her first racehorse, Girl Scout! In 1960, Mary moved from Long Island to Delaware. It was here where she built and ran three horse farms

while her husband trained the horses for the racetrack. During this time, Mary returned to golf, which she learned at an early age in Scarsdale when her father, Udo, was a member of Quaker Ridge Golf Club. During Mary's golf career, she won the club championship in seven different clubs and had more than 10 holes in one. In 1993, at the age of 68, Mary qualified for the USGA Senior Women's Open which was held at Preakness Hills Country Club in New Jersey!

After her retirement in 1988, Mary loved to fish while not playing golf. She and Maje lived at the Ocean Reef Club in Key Largo! Mary won the club championships at both of the courses there and enjoyed the competition well into her 80s!

Mary grew up with Willie Turnesa, the co-founder with Udo of the CSE. In the 90s, Mary was reunited with Willie at the annual Caddie Scholarship Pro-Am. It was a fabulous reunion and great fun listening to Willie sharing so many of the stories of he and Udo.

Mary loved and appreciated the work that is being accomplished at the WGA CSE. Mary was so proud to know the difference this makes to so many caddies on their path in life. Mary will be truly missed!



JOHN J. PINTO

Representing Wykagyl Country Club, where John served as club president, he dedicated more than ten years of service to the WGACSF as Chairman of the Investment Committee and treasurer before assuming the role

of President, a position he held from 2002-2006.

He was the 2002 recipient of the Udo Reinach Award given in recognition of his outstanding support of the fund in the form of time, talent, and treasure. He has left an indelible legacy, and he will be missed.

John was also a member of the Westchester Seniors Golf Association for 20 years. He served on the WSGA Board of Directors as Treasurer and Secretary from 2003 to 2006. In 2017, John was the recipient of the WSGA Distinguished Service Award for his dedication and service to the game of golf.

In lieu of flowers, the Pinto Family and John's friends have requested that gifts be made in John's memory to the WGA Caddie Scholarship Fund. The Fund plans to establish an endowed scholarship in John's name, which will be awarded to scholars from Wykagyl Country Club.

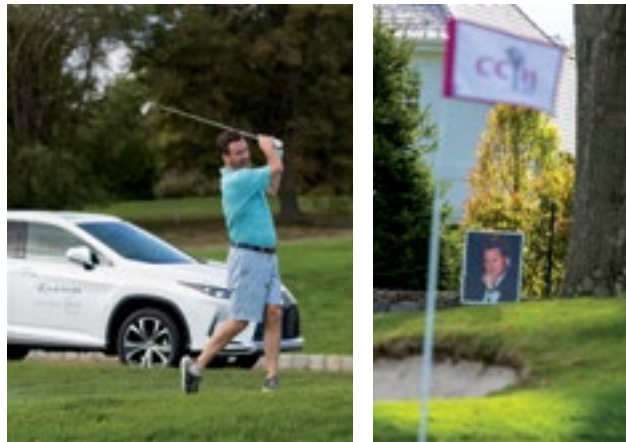

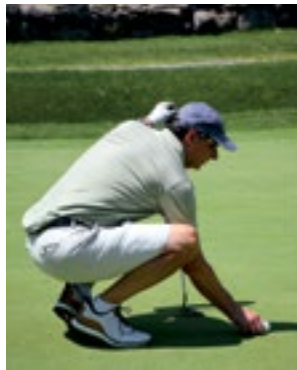
More than 84 golfers competed in the tournament, with many more friends and family joining in the post-golf celebrations, which included a live online auction, prizes, and dinner.

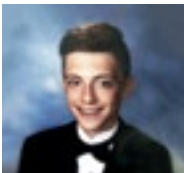

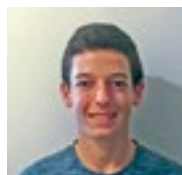

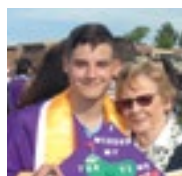

“We are thrilled that Sam is the recipient of the first Jay Mottola Scholarship,” said Johanna Gavin, Director of the MGA Foundation. “As a hard-working, determined, generous and caring young man, Sam displays qualities synonymous with the legacy Jay has made.”

“It was gratifying to see so many great candidates apply, and my family and I are delighted that Sam Masters is the first recipient,” said Mottola. “Sam has an outstanding academic and extracurricular record and impressed the selection committee as a terrific young man. I know the scholarship will help Sam as he completes his college studies at Binghamton University.”

At Binghamton, Masters has kept a schedule that shows his drive to succeed. He continues to gain relevant work experience in his field while also maintaining focus on academics and creating time to volunteer with Big Brother Big Sister and be an active member of the Binghamton Finance Society.

“In addition to the principles a young person learns

while working, it is now clear to me that caddieing provided me the opportunity to realize my goals,” said Masters. “I feel more determined than ever to succeed both academically and personally.”

“The candidates nominated by their local CSFs were exceptional student leaders and had shown dedication in their service to golf, completing many more years at their respective clubs than the two-year requirement,” said Gavin. “The Scholarship Selection Committee was so pleased to hear how influential the candidates’ experiences in the game of golf were in developing their character. We look forward to growing the family of Jay Mottola Scholarship recipients in the coming years and seeing the impact it has on their lives.”
